Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not on Official Entry Forms, Downloaded and/or Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

Mail All Entries With Fees payable to American Beauceron Club to Rebecca Fouts, 19111 E. Truman Rd. Independence, MO 64056. **Entries received without fees will not be accepted.**

Email acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable. **Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor** within a reasonable time, please verify your entry with the event Secretary, Rebecca Fouts at fouts_r@cox.net.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address **without recipient's signature.**

Errors on Entry Forms - Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after show has closed.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to **American Beauceron Club.** Canadian and other foreign exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Post Dated Checks or Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

An Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the enclosed exercising ring.

Bitches in Season will be scheduled last to participate in Rally and Obedience if the handler chooses to compete. There will be a refund of entries due to bitches in season after the match has closed. A Veterinarian's note must accompany any such refund request. Refund subject to \$2.00 processing fee per entry.

Dogs Present will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when being judged or when in the enclosed exercising ring. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercising area.

Event Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

This show will be held outdoors at the Earnest Shepherd Memorial Youth Center, rain or shine. Parking is free. There is ample crating space. Running water will be available. Rally Obedience, Obedience and the CGC test will be held under the Pavilion.

No practicing in the rings is allowed at anytime.
ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES.

Directions to the Show:

From the East: Take I-70 West to MO-291 North (Exit 15B) toward Liberty. Go approximately 14 miles. Take a slight right at S. Leonard Street (MO-33) it will turn into North Lightburne St. Go approximately 3 miles to Shepherd Road. Turn right. The facility will be on your left.

From the West: Take I-70 East (portions of I-70 are a toll road) to MO-291 North (Exit 15B) toward Liberty. Go approximately 14 miles. Take a slight right at S. Leonard Street (MO-33) it will turn into North Lightburne St. Go approximately 3 miles to Shepherd Road. Turn right. The facility will be on your left.

From the North: Take I-35 South to US-69/MO-22 (Exit 20) toward Liberty. Follow the ramp toward US-69/Liberty/MO-33/Excelsior Springs. Bear left onto North Lightburne Street. Turn Left onto Shepherd Road. The facility will be on your left.

From the South: Take I-35 North (Portions of I-35 are a toll road). I-35 North becomes I-435 East. I-435 East becomes I-470 East. Take I-470 East turns into MO-291 North towards Liberty. Take a slight right at S. Leonard Street (MO-33) it will turn into North Lightburne St. Go approximately 3 miles to Shepherd Road. Turn right. The facility will be on your left.

From MCI (Kansas City International)

Take I-435 East toward St. Louis. Travel approximately 9.5 miles and take the MO-291 exit toward I-35 North (Exit 45). Turn right onto MO-291 South. Follow MO-291 South for approximately 5 miles to US-69 North. Merge onto US-69 North (Left hand ramp) toward Cameron. Go approximately 2 miles and turn right onto North Lightburne St/MO-33. Turn Left onto Shepherd Road. Facility will be on your left.

From the Show Hotel:

Go east on Hwy 152 toward MO-291. Turn Left onto MO-291. Merge onto US-69 North. Turn Right onto North Lightburne St/MO-33. Turn Left onto Shepherd Road. Facility will be on your left.
